

Cleaning the luminaires

1. Cleaning the luminaires




Remove dirt such as soil, dust, and rainwater from the light diffuser and the body of the product.

2. Cleaning the outdoor installed luminaires



- Use a non-abrasive cloth or sponge to avoid damaging the paint or anodisation.
- To remove dirt or rainwater, use a microfibre cloth soaked in warm water.

3. Installations near irrigation systems



- To remove light limescale deposits, use a microfibre cloth, warm water and diluted white vinegar.
- To remove layers of calcified limescale, use an anti-limescale product diluted with warm water and a microfibre cloth.

4. Prohibitions



- Do not use pressure washers.
- Do not use alcohol.
- Do not use abrasive cloths.
- During installation, avoid using lubricants such as oils, greases or their derivatives, as they can affect the durability of plastic components.



Before performing any operation ensure that the mains power supply has been disconnected
